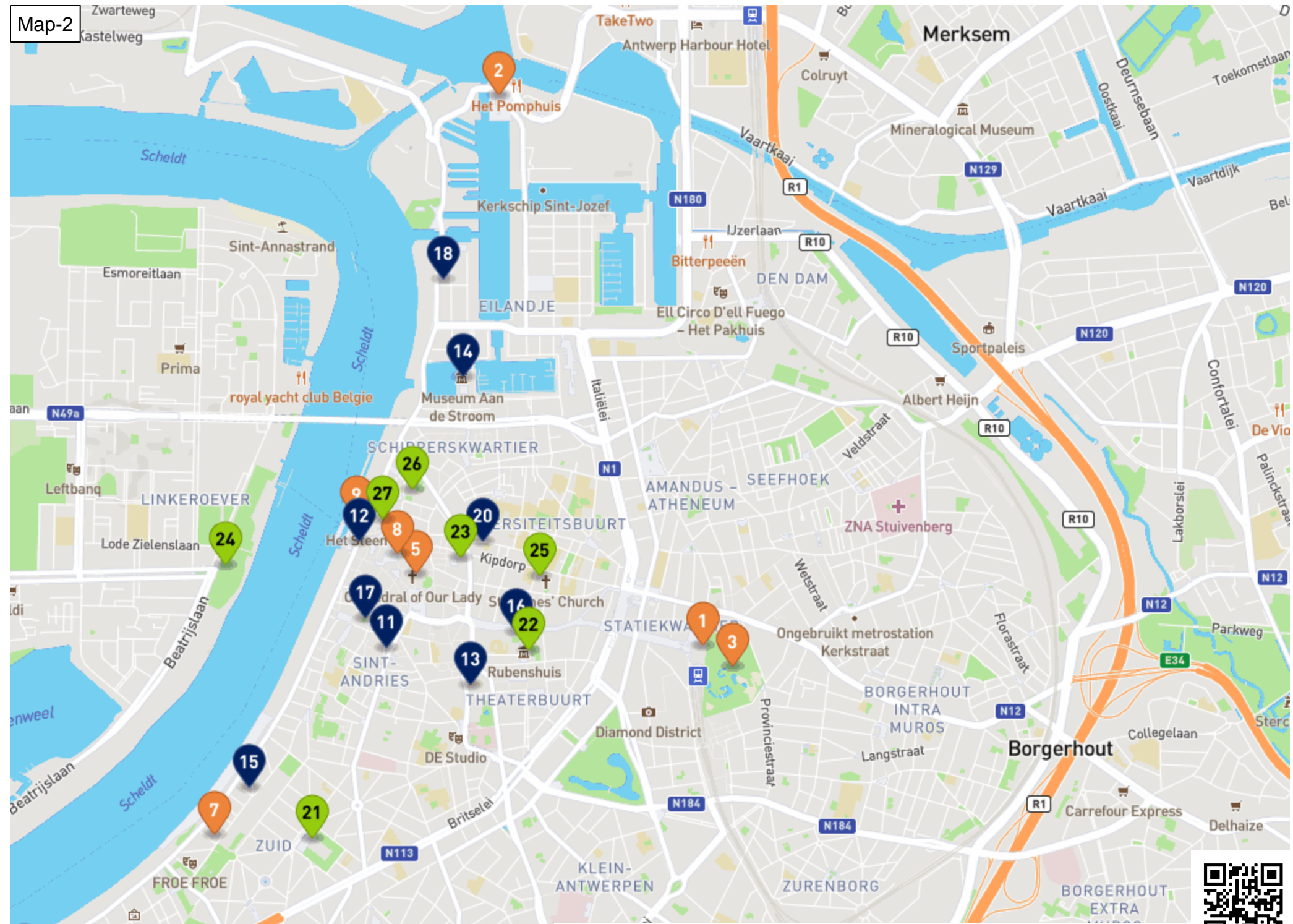

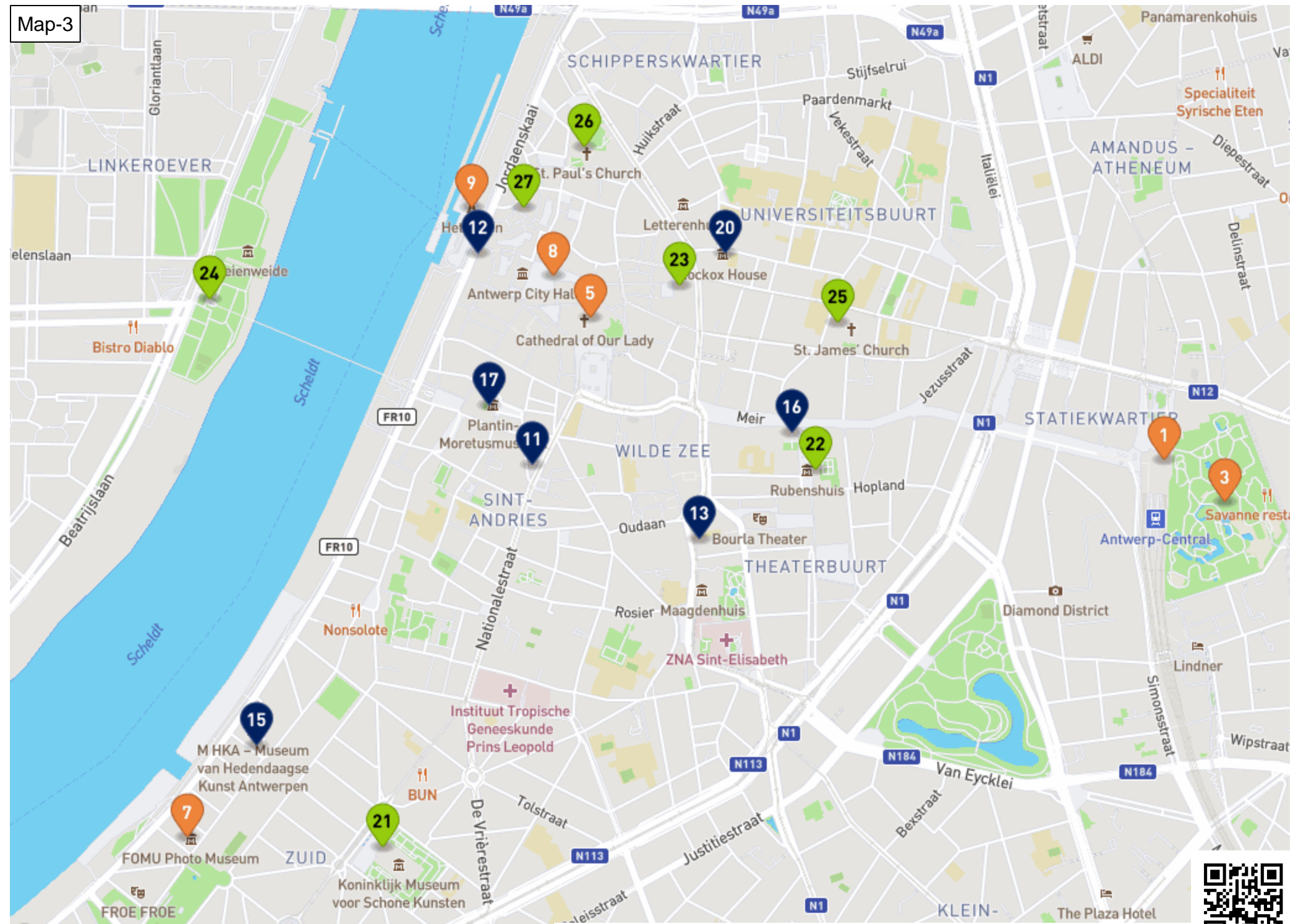

- 1** **Antwerp Central Station**  
The city's main railway station, which is counted among the most beautiful stations in the world (Map-1,2,3)
- 2** **Antwerp Port**  
Located on the bank of the river Scheldt, it is the second largest port in Europe (Map-1,2)
- 3** **Antwerp Zoo**  
Oldest and best-known zoos in Europe with over 5000 animals and more than 950 different species (Map-1,2,3)
- 4** **Arboretum Kalmthout**  
Famous botanical garden with many different plant species dating back 150 years
- 5** **Cathedral of Our Lady Antwerp**  
A 14th century Roman Catholic cathedral whose spire still dominates the city skyline (Map-1,2,3)
- 6** **De Koninck**  
An iconic Belgian brewery and beer brand that offers guided tours (Map-1)
- 7** **Fotomuseum Antwerp**  
Features a historical and contemporary collection of photography (Map-1,2,3)
- 8** **Grand Place**  
The central plaza located right in the middle of the old town (Map-1,2,3)
- 9** **Het Steen**  
A medieval stone fortress which is the city's oldest building from the 13th century (Map-1,2,3)
- 10** **Middelheim Open Air Sculpture Museum**  
Enjoy sculpture artwork in one of the finest open air museums in Europe

- 11** **ModeMuseum**  
Focuses on Belgian contemporary fashion designers including the Antwerp Six (Map-1,2,3)
- 12** **Museum De Reede**  
View a one of kind collection of 150 graphic works spanning over five centuries (Map-1,2,3)
- 13** **Museum Mayer van den Bergh**  
Features art work collected by Fritz Mayer van den Bergh from the Gothic and Renaissance period (Map-1,2,3)
- 14** **Museum aan de Stroom**  
The largest and most unique museum in Antwerp showcasing the city's many aspects (Map-1,2)
- 15** **Museum of Contemporary Art**  
A museum dedicated to the history of printing and publishing (Map-1,2,3)
- 16** **Paleis op de Meir**  
The central plaza located right in the middle of the old town (Map-1,2,3)
- 17** **Plantin-Moretus Museum**  
A museum dedicated to the history of printing and publishing (Map-1,2,3)
- 18** **Red Star Line Museum**  
Explore the lives and voyage of over 2 million people who emigrated from Eastern Europe to America (Map-1,2)
- 19** **Rivierenhof**  
A massive park with a wide variety of recreational activities (Map-1)
- 20** **Rockox House**  
Discover famous works of old masters in a beautiful setting (Map-1,2,3)

- 21** **Royal Museum of Fine Arts Antwerp**  
Features a massive collection of fine arts from the 15th century until the present (Map-1,2,3)
- 22** **Rubenshuis**  
The 17th century home and studio of Baroque painter Peter Paul Rubens, which is now a museum (Map-1,2,3)
- 23** **Saint Carolus Borromeus Church**  
The 17th century home and studio of Baroque painter Peter Paul Rubens, which is now a museum (Map-1,2,3)
- 24** **St. Anna's Tunnel**  
The city's main railway station, which is counted among the most beautiful stations in the world (Map-1,2,3)
- 25** **St. James' Church**  
A church with rich interiors including paintings and statues from the Renaissance and baroque period (Map-1,2,3)
- 26** **St. Paul's Church**  
One of the finest Dominican churches of Antwerp built in unique Baroque & Gothic style architecture (Map-1,2,3)
- 27** **Vleeshuis**  
Museum that focuses on Antwerp's rich history of music and dance (Map-1,2,3)
