

- 1** **Army and Military History Museum**  
Planes, tanks and all things military are displayed in an 1875 building (Map-1)
- 2** **Atomium**  
A wacky building that looks like an atom and houses scientific exhibits (Map-1)
- 3** **Autoworld**  
250 vintage, classic and state-of-the-art cars are on display here (Map-1)
- 4** **BELvue**  
Exhibits on the history of Belgium are displayed in the former Belvue Hotel (Map-1,2)
- 5** **Belgian Comic Strip Center**  
See life-size cartoon figures, Tintin, comic strips and more (Map-1)
- 6** **Belgian Royal Palace**  
See the exterior to this beautiful palace and stroll through the royal gardens (Map-1,2)
- 7** **Cacao and chocolate museum**  
Learn about and taste the famous Belgian chocolate (Map-1,2)
- 8** **Cinquantenaire Museum**  
A Royal Museum of Art and History covering archaeological artifacts (Map-1)
- 9** **Costume and Lace Museum**  
Learn about famous Belgian lace and see traditional costumes (Map-1,2)
- 10** **Coudenberg**  
Site of former Palace of Coudenberg, tour the underground foundations and rooms (Map-1,2)
- 11** **EU Parliament**  
Tour the rooms where the EU Parliament meets (Map-1)
- 12** **Eglise Notre-Dame du Sablon**  
A 15th century Gothic church holding relics, statues and art work (Map-1,2)
- 13** **Eglise St-Nicolas**  
Church highlights include the painting by Rubens and the 1131 Vladimir icon (Map-1,2)
- 14** **Grand Place**  
The central square in Brussels that is a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- 15** **Horta Museum**  
Dedicated to architect designer Victor Horta's life and work (Map-1)
- 16** **Hotel de Ville**  
Brussels' town hall, a Gothic masterpiece completed in 1444 (Map-1,2)
- 17** **Jardin Botanique**  
A complex metal and glass 19th century greenhouses (Map-1)
- 18** **Magritte Museum**  
See the surrealist work of artist Rene Magritte displayed in neo-classical building (Map-1,2)
- 19** **Manneken Pis**  
Famous statue and fountain of a little boy peeing on a corner (Map-1,2)
- 20** **Mini Europe**  
Europe has been recreated in miniature, including famous landmarks (Map-1)
- 21** **Musee d'Ixelles**  
13,000 works are on show including Picasso, Magritte, Toulouse-Lautrec etc (Map-1)
- 22** **Museum David and Alice van Buuren**  
An art-deco house where 15th - 19th century art is displayed among the furnishings
- 23** **Museum of Natural Sciences**  
See the country's collection of anthropological, geological and zoological items (Map-1)
- 24** **Museum of the City of Brussels**  
this museum focuses on the folklore, history, culture and development of Brussels (Map-1,2)
- 25** **Musical Instrument Museum**  
See 9,000 musical instruments from all regions, periods and cultures (Map-1,2)
- 26** **Royal Greenhouses of Laeken**  
Former orangery is home to a cultural center surrounded by beautiful gardens (Map-1)
- 27** **Royal Museums of Fine Arts**  
A huge establishment displaying world-class art from several periods (Map-1,2)
- 28** **St. Michael and St. Gudula Cathedral**  
Stunning church and site of all royal religious ceremonies, dating back to 1047 (Map-1,2)
- 29** **Train World**  
Impressive railway museum with over 1,200 objects on display including 22 locomotives
